### THE 6th GREAT NOTTINGHAM INCLOSURE WALK

## Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> June 2008

This free walk passes through the historic green spaces of central Nottingham finishing at the Inclosure Oak on the Forest Recreation Ground. Short talks will be given at places of interest.

We celebrate the 1845 Inclosure Act which allotted 130 acres of Recreation Ground in perpetuity to the people of Nottingham, and honour the memory of the Mayor and Corporation of 163 years ago, who had the foresight to lay it out to the highest standards.

5 miles of smooth surfaces suitable for powered wheelchairs or even pushchairs if you are strong - it has been done! You can then take the bus or tram to return to the city centre or the station. Certificate given at end.
